

Assignments in the Elementary Experience - Instructors

The Elementary Experience provides a new workflow for students submitting assignments. Teachers create assignments in the Elementary Experience in the same way as they do in their other courses. Students will then be presented with the following submit options:

- Photo
- Record Video
- Record Audio
- Upload
- Type

The Elementary theme must be enabled in your course to use the Elementary Experience assignment workflow. If you do not see the Course Theme option in your course settings, reach out to your Support Contact.

Student View

Students can take a photo, record audio/video, upload a file, type on their device, and submit to the assignment.

Reviewing and Grading Submissions

Teachers can review and grade submissions in the same way they do with assignments in non-Elementary themed courses.

You can access an ungraded assignment from the Reminders section on your home page or click the name of the student in the Submissions column on the assignment page.
